In the course of providing educational programming for the students of Miami-Yoder School District, the Board of Education encourages students to take advantage of educational opportunities, offered by other cooperative institutions, including colleges, universities and vocational schools. The following stipulations apply for students electing to attend such institutions:

Post-Secondary Educational Options: For those students seeking an Associates or Bachelors degree, applicants must:

- Be in their junior (11th grade) or senior (12th grade) year,
- Provide the district with \$300.00 deposit in the form of check, money order, or cashier's check
- Juniors must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.40 in all core subjects (math, English, social studies, and science).
- Seniors must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.00 in all core subjects (math, English, social studies, and science).
- Juniors applying for the program during the Spring of their sophomore (10th grade year), must have scored proficient on the 9th grade reading, writing, and mathematics CSAP test, and if available, have scored a minimum of 19 on the Colorado ACT, and have passed the ACCU-PLACER exam given by the institution of higher education. In addition, the student must present the principal with two letters of recommendation from teachers in the core areas (high school), recommending attendance.
- Seniors applying for the program during the Spring of their junior (11th grade year), must have scored proficient on the 10th grade reading, writing, and science CSAP test and must have scored a minimum of "high partially proficient" on the 10th grade math CSAP test. If available, the student must have scored a minimum of 17 on the Colorado ACT, and have passed the ACCU-PLACER exam given by the institution of higher education. In addition, the student must present the principal with two letters of recommendation from teachers in the core areas (high school), recommending attendance.
- Have written permission from parents/guardians and complete a signed contract stipulating to the conditions of attendance and possible financial requirements.
- Submit an application to the secondary principal, no later than February 15th of the school year for fall attendance and October 15th, for spring attendance.

• Must show proof of acceptance to the chosen college.

Students approved for college course work must:

- Adhere to Miami-Yoder School District's eligibility standards and attendance policies. If a student is
 absent from a college class, the parent must call Miami-Yoder High School within 24 hours to report
 the absence and circumstances surrounding the absence. Absences exceeding 8 per semester shall be
 grounds for forfeiture of the student's right to attend and the student/parent/guardian may incur
 substantial monetary penalties.
- The student must maintain a 2.00 GPA. If the GPA slips below 2.00, the student will be considered for administrative review to determine credits and continued enrollment status. In addition, all classes below the 2.00 GPA resulting in a loss of full-time status with the Colorado Department of Education may result in severe monetary penalties to the student/parent/guardian.
- Unless otherwise approved, students are required to return to Miami-Yoder High School for afternoon classes in order to meet graduation requirements.
- Student and parent(s)/guardian(s) must agree to all rules and regulations regarding college attendance.
