

## IKC Valedictorian and Salutatorian Selection

The Board recognizes the importance of a consistent method of identifying and establishing class standing. The following procedures set the method for determining Valedictorian and Salutatorian.

1. The student with the highest index scored, determined using the Colorado Commission on Higher Education Eligibility Index- IKC-E, will be Valedictorian and the second highest index score will be Salutatorian. In the event of a tie by two or more students, both or all shall share in the title of Valedictorian.
2. The index score is tabulated using a chart that uses the student's grade point average and the Colorado assessment test given to all Colorado High School students in their junior year.

The student must have attended Miami-Yoder for 4 consecutive semesters (students enrolling after the end of the first semester of their sophomore year are not eligible).

3. All college classes taken with the numerical codes of 100 level, 200 level, 300 level, and 400 level will be treated as honors classes and grades will be rated on a five point grading scale. A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, and F=0.  
All non-honors classes at Miami-Yoder High School and Pikes Peak Community College Area Vocational Program Classes will be considered regular classes and will be figured on the four points (4 pts.) scale.  
A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1, and F=0
4. The student must have a minimum GPA of 3.0.
