Supervision of Students

During all contact hours that a teacher is on district property and is performing services on behalf of the school district, and while performing such services at school sponsored activities off district property, the teacher will be responsible for the control of all students that fall within his/her assigned supervision and to other students physically in his/her presence.

Supervision of students on school property shall be provided under the direction of the building principal for a reasonable time before and after classes are in session. Parents should not allow their children to arrive at school before adequate supervision is available.

Teachers shall be responsible for the supervision of students on playgrounds as assigned by the principal. Teachers shall be conscious at all times of students' activities. Students should be given every opportunity to organize their own games.

If students use playground equipment during non-school hours, such use shall be the responsibility of the parents.

Athletic contests or school sponsored activities should not be construed as opportunities for parents to drop off students, to be supervised by school teachers or administrator. Students under age of thirteen (13) should not be left unattended on campus and parental supervision is required for all students not directly involved in the athletic event or school sponsored activity.

Custodians will not be assigned the responsibility for supervising students.

Teacher shall not be expected to supervise students at public performance sponsored by agencies other than the school.
