3.00 Salaries

- If we decide to approve these, the budget is not set yet. We have someone out in June and want to get this set before she is out.
- We have included a 50 cents an hour for classified and 500 on the salary schedule for teachers. This will take the base to 32,000.00. We also wanted to take the BA+48 all the way to 30 years.
- We have a reduction of cost with Sharon leaving.
- We will have an increase in our college fund as we are sending 17 students to Pikes Peak college, we have a reduction in costs as we are letting Mitch go from BOCES
- By May we should have everything locked down with the budget.
- The tabor cap could go down if they move the hospital provider fee to an enterprise tax. This would get out from under TABOR and could free up more money for education.
- For the Business Manager Salary schedule, the left side is wrong. All the salaries are correct, the percent's were wrong.

3.01 Superintendent Eval

- The superintendent Eval is finished and we will go over in the Executive Session. Robyn will hand out the copies then.

3.02 Green house

- The equipment shed is done except for the doors. The last big project is the green house. We have three quotes for them. Mr. Sifford gave us a quote for a pole barn type of green house. That is constructed, with all equipment for about 30,000.00.
- The second greenhouse quote is for 21,500. That is just the kit and it is not snow rated for our area. It would cost another 15 to 25,000.00 to erect it.
- The third greenhouse is 80,000.00.
- FFA would be using the greenhouse and I think once the student see how much they can make, we will see lots of green thumbs coming out

to raise plants. Science and elementary are both looking at using the greenhouse for different projects.

- We budgeted 60,000.00 for the greenhouse.

3.03 UIP

- Mrs. Hartley, we presented to the DAC our UIP. They had a couple minor changes. We are using Data Driven Instruction and continue the small group instruction. Make sure we are doing trainings throughout the year. Involve our students in their goals. Even though we have a school policy, we are going to be more consistent.
- Goals we set are Math and Reading Achievement.
- Mr. Barnes, we are going to change the assessment by using the pre-ACT. It is called ACT inspire. ACT inspire will help the students with their career plans.
- We will have 30 to 40 percent of our kids off campus taking classes.
