### 3.00 Work Session

- Policy BCB
  - Looked at other districts policies (local ones)
  - Mr. Carneal said he would be happy to see a provision that states no one directly under the Superintendent
  - Mrs. Darby said to look at the line Limon has that states part time, subs, etc.
  - It was stated that they can reword this one paragraph to whatever they wanted, don't think it should be someone who is a manager and directly supervised by the Superintendent
  - The questions was asked, what if someone was moved to that position during their four year term? It was stated that they would be allowed to finish out their term
  - It was suggested to follow Limon's policy with stipulation that if no interest then employees can run
  - Current board members that are staff are grandfathered in
  - First Reading Next Month
- Policy GCG/GCGB
  - It was asked how often does it happen that a substitute's days are consecutive, but in different classrooms? Should they get this perk? Mr. Barnes said, "No, they are not building lesson plans as the teacher like long term subs.

- She talked about their Priority Performance and Root Causes

- She talked about the last part of the UIP which is their targets

# Secondary:

- Mrs. Brewer still has much more data to put in so she did not pass a copy out
- o High School SAT- students are maintaining
- Focus is mostly on middle school ELA, this year we split 6<sup>th</sup> grade and 8<sup>th</sup> grade into smaller groups and we added more paras
- o 7<sup>th</sup> grade is all together in one class this makes it harder to manage and they move at a slower pace
- CMAS Math score have dropped a bit, looking at a possible different curriculum with common core since CMAS focuses on this, next year we hope to have smaller classes and new Math curriculum
- Also looking for ways we can build climate for students to want to be here and to do well, working with teachers on how we can do this

#### - District:

- Focus on staff retention, in ten years we've only had one year that Middle School staff remained the same
- o Next year we are looking at having to find 2-5 new teachers

#### Student Count

- Oct. 1 count was 355 which is K-12 and prep academy
  - Numbers down in Middle School & High School
  - Elementary numbers are probably up
- We look at the 1,2,3,4,5 year average
- December we will know PPR for sure
- We were given funding already at 420 students so we will be adjusting things in December

## • Critical Shortage Resolution

- Allows the school to hire critical shortage staff from retired people
- Can only work under this for 5 years
- Different from 140 which we can have 10 people do this as long as they want
- This would be full time 160 days
